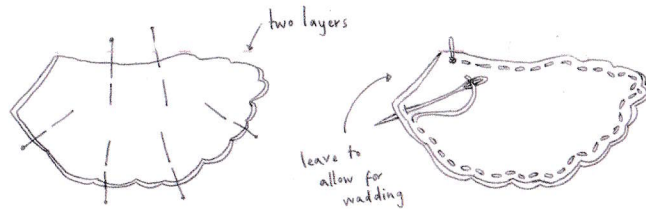


# How to create a three dimensional bird.

**Step four:** take wing one & wing two & place them on top of each other.

the print on each wing should be touching so it looks like its inside out & pin together.



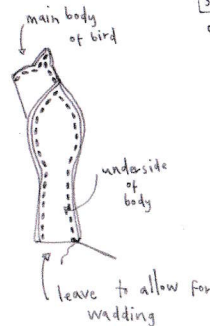
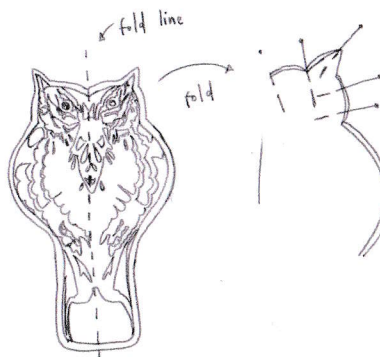
**Step five:** stitch around the wing leaving space for wadding.

**Step six:** Repeat with wing three & four.

**Step seven:** take the main body of bird & fold the fabric in half, again so the print is facing inward then pin the head & neck together.

**Step eight:** stitch the neck & head together

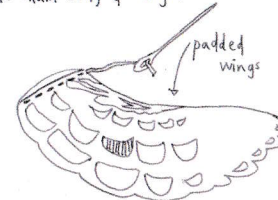
**Step ten:** stitch the main body of bird to the underside of bird, leaving space for wadding.



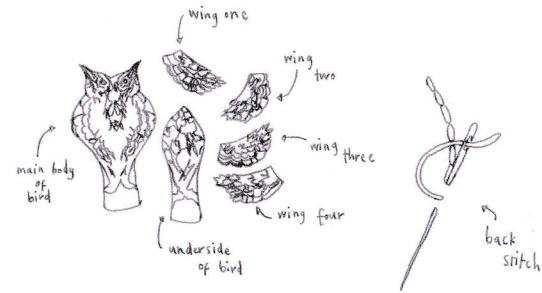
Finally take the underside of bird & pin it to the main body of bird again with the print on the inside.

**Step eleven:** turn all the pieces inside out so the print is on the outside.

**Step twelve:** cut the wadding into bite size pieces & stuff the main body & wings.

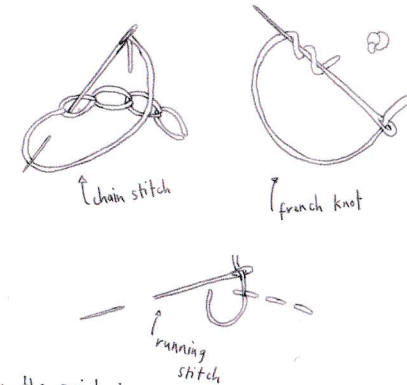


**Step fourteen:** Finally place the wings onto the body & sew them in place.



**Step two:** lay out all the pattern pieces.

**Step three:** embellish your bird to make it unique.



**Step thirteen:** To finish the edges &

seal the padded sections fold the excess fabric inwards & use an invisible stitch to pull the fabric together.
